McMASTERS Cemetery

The directions to McMasters Cemetery are as follows: from NC Hwy. 22, between Franklinville and Ramseur, turn onto Patterson Grove Church Road. At the end turn left onto SR 2442, Ramseur-Julian Road; right onto SR 2456, White's Chapel Road, for 1 1/2 miles; left onto SR 2458, Soapstone Mountain Road. Approximately 3 miles on the left is a sign. The cemetery is behind a couple of old trailers. This cemetery is fenced in and well kept

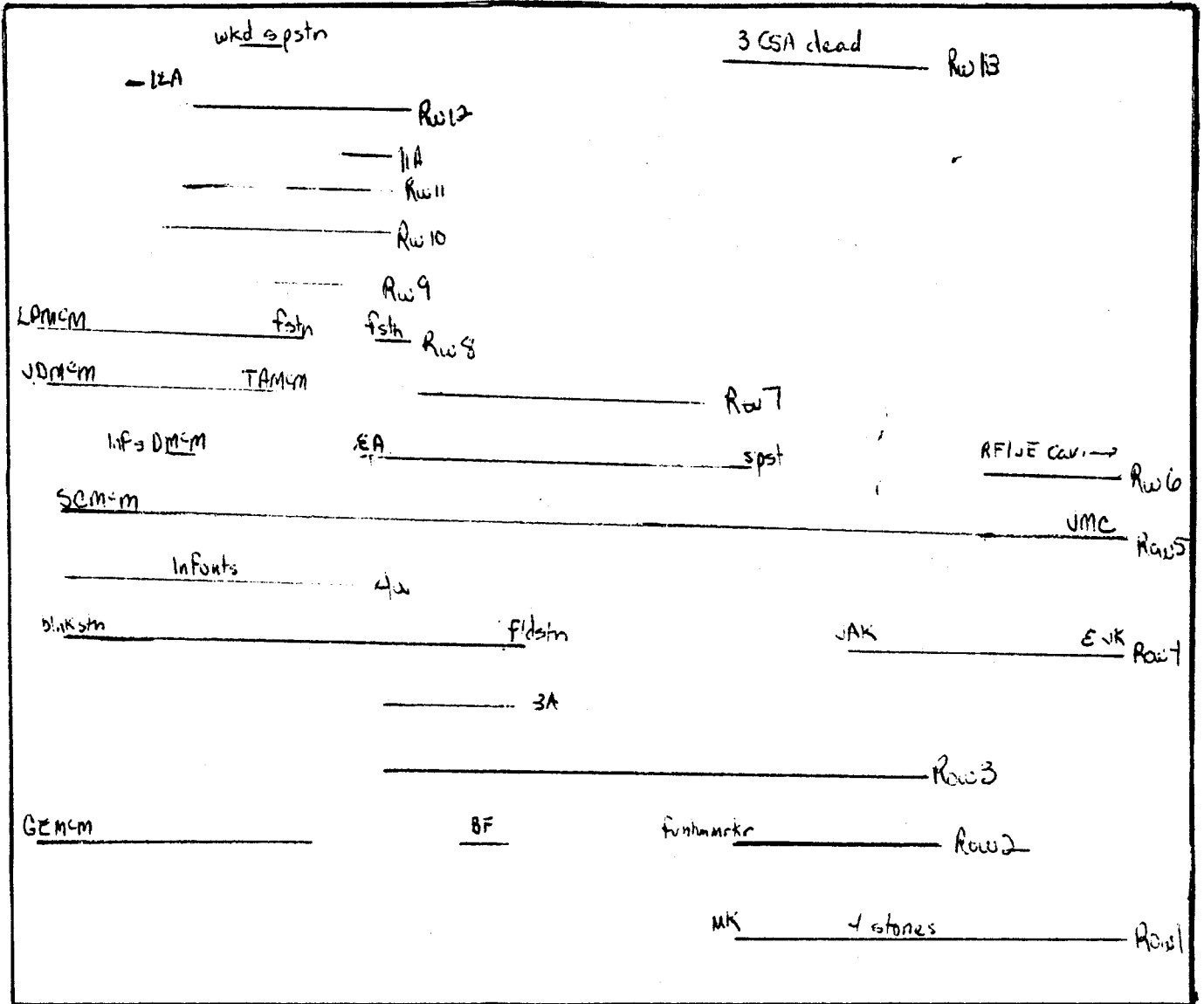

As this is a very ancient burial ground many, if not most, of the graves are unmarked. The map is designed to show the layout of the graves that remain visible and their relationship to one another. Initials are those of the graves at the beginning and ending of certain lines and should be used in conjunction with the cemetery reading on the preceding four pages. (LWC)
